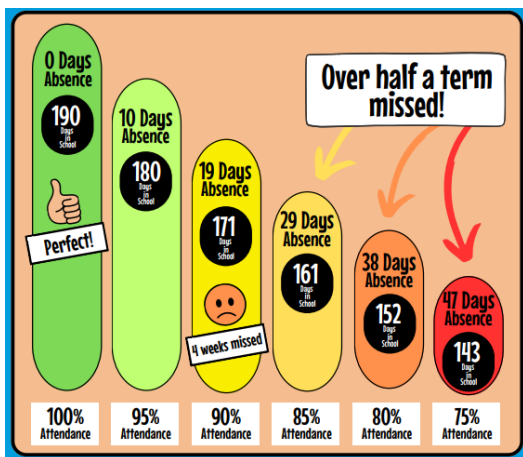
Mobile Phones
